PARENTPAY Online Payment Scheme

The Sims Agora online payment service stopped being used in March. Any credit held in this service was transferred to ScholarPack (our management information system).

ParentPay is now used as an online payment service. We are not using the dinner money section, if you pay money into this section by mistake it will be held in a parent account until you choose a payment item. The school only sees payments made to payment items. This money is then put in ScholarPack for dinner payment items (year 3).

If you would like to know how much money is in credit for dinners for your child please contact the school office. Letters will be sent home on a Friday if dinner money is outstanding.

ParentPay can be used to pay for Rosettes breakfast and after school clubs, trips, Y3 dinner money, book bags and Y3 ties. Activation letters were sent home to set up accounts, if you need another letter please contact the school office.

ROSETTES OUT OF SCHOOL CLUBS

Booking forms are now available to download from the school website and school app. From September paper copies will not be sent home but will still be available from the school office.

Can we remind parents that the booking forms must be handed in or emailed at least two weeks prior to the booking (including regular bookings). This is to ensure that there is sufficient staff to cover the clubs and to avoid disappointment. We may be able to accommodate short notice bookings, if numbers allow, due to an emergency or short notice work commitment.
