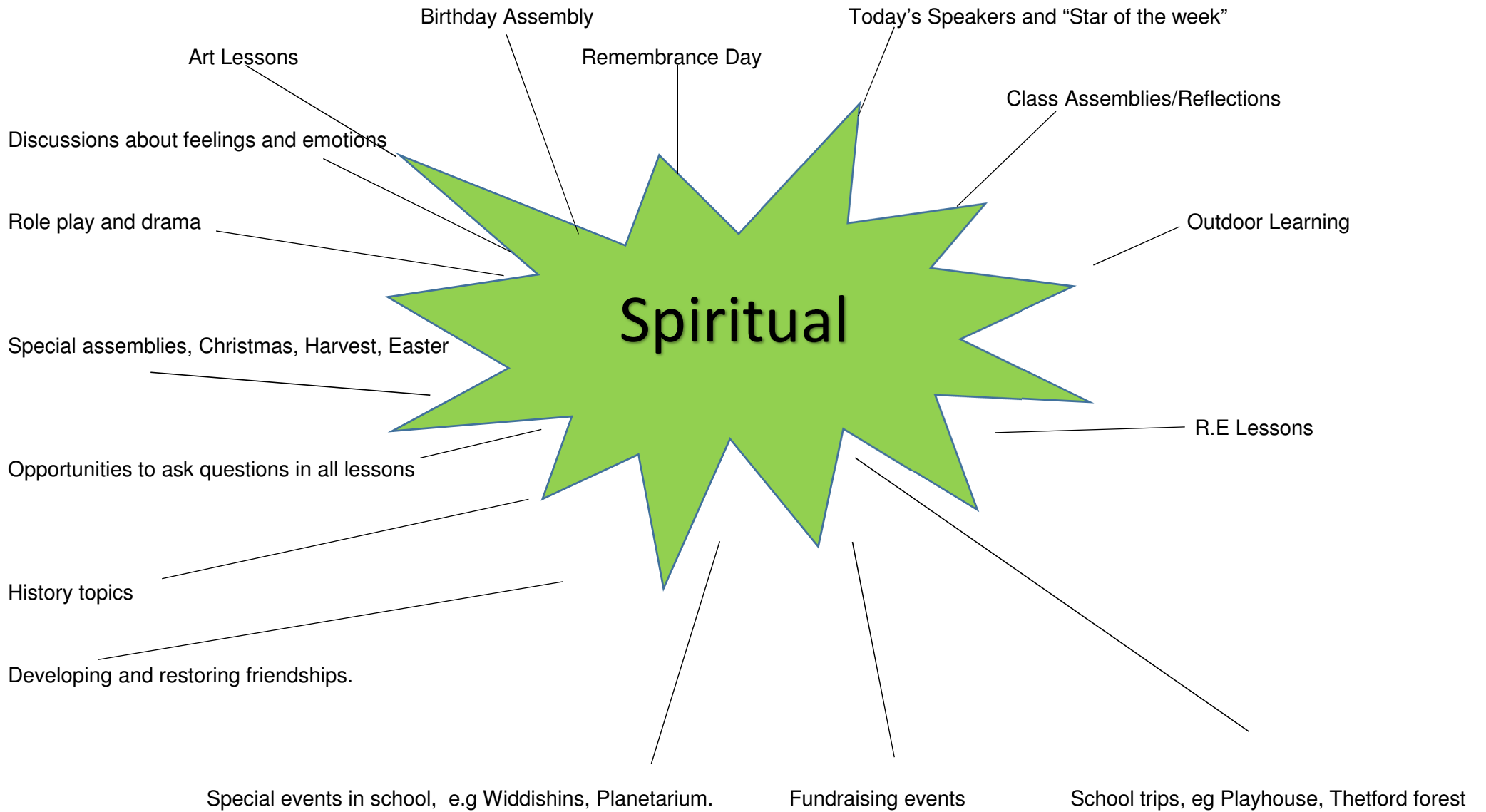


## How Spiritual development is promoted within Rosecroft Primary 2017-18

<p>What does this look like in Rosecroft Primary School</p>	<p>Moral development is largely about how the choices you make affect you and others around you.</p> <p>Moral development refers to a pupil's understanding of the choices they make and their attitude and behaviour to what is right what is wrong. This is developed by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Providing a clear moral code for behaviour which is promoted consistently through all aspects of the school; for example, learning animals; Thrive; class rules; PSHE; school council; a positive approach to behaviour by all members of staff.</li> <li>• Respecting others who are different from ourselves: for example, PSHE; RE; fundraising; visitors; cooking</li> <li>• Developing a safe learning environment in which pupils can express their views (school council; PSHE; drama; RE; Thrive)</li> <li>• Encouraging children to take responsibility for their actions; for example, respect for property, care of the environment, healthy schools, internet safety lessons and behaviour policy.</li> <li>• Reinforcing the school's values and pupil diversity through the use of posters, displays, newsletters, school brochure etc.</li> </ul>
